GENERAL DESCRIPTION

- The MRM Specialist is responsible for the design, improvement, management, and maintenance of the project MRM system according to defined standards.
- She/ he manages the planning and reporting processes of E4E@MK.
- She/ he advises TL in the strategic project steering with respect to its defined objectives.
- She/ he supports in enhancing the knowledge of the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) and the project partners, providing an evidence-based decision-making.
- She/ he supports the PIU and the project partners to understand the progress, results, and learning from the project's interventions.

MAIN JOB TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Designs, continuously improves, maintains, and manages the project MRM system.
- Leads research design and coordination of data collection for defined interventions.
- Supports project partners to report essential information required by the MRM system.
- Coaches other PIU members on aspects of the MRM system that they use in their daily work.
- Manages internal strategic project review and steering, in coordination with TL.
- Provides indicators of performance/ results and reporting to external stakeholders.
- Cooperates with the Swiss Embassy in North Macedonia and other Swiss financed projects in the alignment of MRM baselines, indicators, and projections.
- Participates in the public promotion of the project.
- Reviews narrative reports from partners / service providers (incl. field visits).
- Ensures that transversal topics are incorporated within the project, both in the project's strategic documents and activities.
- Manages semi-annual reporting, annual reporting, and end-of-phase reporting to SDC and Helvetas in cooperation with the TL.
